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## Shifts

Our full time support workers work on a three weeks rolling rota and this is the combination of early shifts (7:30-15:30), late shifts (14:30-21:00) and long days (7:30-21:00). There is also training day rotated every three weeks on Tuesday (9:30-18:00). Below is the template of how this works:
